ŠTUDENTI VARSTVOSLOVJA RAZISKUJEJO AMERIKO

Študenti (v sestavi Tara Pahor, Veronika Saje, Kiti Skočir, Alen Golobič, Matej Enci in Tine Mesarič) prvega letnika magistrskega študijskega programa Varstvoslovje Fakultete za varnostne vede Univerze v Mariboru smo v sredo, 5. 3. 2025, pod vodstvom red. prof. dr. Gorazda Meška in izr. prof. dr. Roka Hacina nekaj minut pred 10. uro zjutraj poleteli z Letališča Jožeta Pučnika Ljubljana (bolje poznano kot Brnik) proti Združenim državam Amerike (ZDA). Na poti v ZDA smo v Frankfurtu v hitrem tempu preselili še na povezovalni let in po skoraj 11 urah pristali »čez lužo« v Denverju, prestolnici zvezne države Kolorado.

Denver je s približno 600.000 prebivalci 26. največje mesto ZDA ter glavno in največje mesto v zahodni zvezni državi Kolorado. Mesto leži na 1.609 metrih nadmorske višine (kar je točno eno miljo nad morsko gladino),

zato je dobilo mesto tudi vzdevek Mile-High City. Utemeljeno sumimo, da je ta višina tisti dejavnik, zaradi katerega smo se vsako jutro zbujali z zamašenim nosom. Mesto je leta 1858 ustanovil poslovnež in politik William Larimer in ga poimenoval po takratnem guvernerju Jamesu Denverju. Slednji je kasneje sicer odstopil, ime mesta pa se je kljub temu obdržalo.

Po rahlem kulturnem šoku smo si privoščili ramen (krepčilna japonska juha) in v večernih urah, utrujeni od »jetлага«, komaj čakali, da ležemo k počitku. Četrtek, prvi dan po prihodu v Denver, nam je prof. dr. Mary Dodge predstavila Colorado University of Denver, obiskali pa smo še univerzitetno policijo Auraria Campus Police Department, ki skrbi za red in mir znotraj celotnega območja kampusa. Z veseljem so nam razkazali prostore, videli smo vse od njihove sodobne opreme do celice za pridržanje ... najbolj zanimiva pa nam je bila soba z dokazi, ki je oddajala zanimive »vonjave«.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY STUDENTS EXPLORE AMERICA

On Wednesday, March 5, 2025, students (Tara Pahor, Veronika Saje, Kiti Skočir, Alen Golobič, Matej Enci and Tine Mesarič) in their first year of the Master's program in Criminal Justice and Security at the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security of the University of Maribor, under the leadership of Professor Gorazd Meško, PhD, and Associate Professor Rok Hacin, PhD, flew from Ljubljana Jože Pučnik Airport (better known as Brnik) to the United States of America (USA). On the way to the USA, we quickly changed to a connecting flight in Frankfurt and after almost 11 hours landed "across the pond" in Denver, the capital of the state of Colorado.

Denver, with a population of approximately 600,000, is the 26th largest city in the United States and the capital and largest city in the western state of Colorado. The city is located at an altitude of 1,609 meters above sea level (exactly one mile), which is why the city was nicknamed the Mile-High City.

We have reason to suspect that this altitude is the reason that we awakened with a stuffy nose every morning. The city was founded in 1858 by businessman and politician, William Larimer, and named after then-governor, James Denver. Although the latter later resigned, the name of the city has nevertheless been retained.

After a slight culture shock, we enjoyed ramen (a hearty Japanese soup) and in the evening, tired from "jet lag", we could hardly wait to lie down and rest. Thursday, the first day after arriving in Denver, Professor Mary Dodge, PhD, showed us the University Denver, and we also visited the university police, the Auraria Campus Police Department, which is responsible for law and order within the entire campus area. They were happy to show us around the premises. We saw everything from their modern equipment to the detention cell ... but the most interesting thing for us was the evidence room, which emitted most interesting "smells".

V nadaljevanju dneva smo imeli posebno priložnost (ki jo je uredila naša gostiteljica prof. dr. Mary Dodge s *Colorado University Denver*), da smo si ogledali *Colorado Supreme Court* in *Colorado Court of Appeals* (vrhovno in višje/pritožbeno sodišče). V stavbi, ki je vredna vrtoglavih 264 milijonov dolarjev (več kot 2 milijona dolarjev so porabili samo za umetnine!), smo v dveh sodnih dvoranah spoznali anglosaški pravosodni sistem. Imeli smo priložnost govoriti s sodnikom na pritožbenem sodišču, s katerim smo imeli zanimivo debato o kaznovanju, nadeli pa smo si lahko tudi pravo sodniško togo.

Later in the day, we had a special opportunity (arranged by our host, Professor Mary Dodge, PhD, from Colorado University Denver) to tour the Colorado Supreme Court and the Colorado Court of Appeals. In a building worth a staggering \$264 million (more than \$2 million was spent on the artwork alone!), in two courtrooms, we got ourselves familiar with the Anglo-Saxon justice system. We had the opportunity to speak with a judge on the Court of Appeals, with whom we had an interesting debate about sentencing. We also had a chance to put on a real judge's robe.


Capitol Main Hall –Debate on guns

Komaj smo čakali, da si ogledamo NBA tekmo med lokalno ekipo Denver Nuggets in Phoenix Suns. Ekipa Nuggetsov je do zmage v podaljšku (končni rezultat 149:141) popeljal srbski košarkaši superzvezdnik Nikola Jokić, ki je z osebno statistiko 31 točk, 22 asistenc in 21 skokov spisal zgodovino v ligi NBA. Zvesti navijači iz Slovenije



We could not wait to watch the NBA game between the local Denver Nuggets and the visiting Phoenix Suns. The Nuggets team was led to an overtime victory (final score 149:141) by Serbian basketball superstar Nikola Jokić, who made NBA history with personal statistics of 31 points, 22 assists and 21 rebounds (a rare “triple-double”). Before Jokić, who literally reigned supreme in the game, no one had ever managed such a feat - a triple-double with at least 30 points and at least 20 rebounds and assists in a single game. At the same time, we had the opportunity to hear the American national anthem performed live for the first time. We could also feel and see the excitement in the packed hall through the fan cameras, which unfortunately were not directed at us.

On Saturday, we had a meeting with the Honorary Consul of Slovenia in Colorado, Mrs. Tamara Gorenc. Together with her husband Miro, they represent a key point of contact for Slovenians living in or visiting Colorado.

The Honorary Consul presented to us the forms of cooperation between Slovenia and the USA and her role in connecting the two countries. They prepared a typical American “barbeque” dinner and sweetened us with a traditional American pie (the professors needed cholesterol pills, but our youth helped us). Their daughter and her husband also joined us, accompanied by their adorable dog Sai. Once again, we sincerely thank them for their hospitality and the welcome shown.

Na več kot 2.000 metrih in več kot 200 milijonov let v preteklosti

Malo za šalo, malo zares, smo dejali, da nismo bili v celem življenju v toliko muzejih, kot smo bili sedaj v nekaj dneh! Zvečer smo se sestali še z Alenovim sorodnikom Fredijem, ki v Denverju živi že dobrih 26 let in opravlja službo poklicnega gasilca in reševalca. Ostali smo odprtih ust, ko nam je pripovedoval o svojem delu, posebno takrat, ko je omenil, da imajo v Denverju letno preko 300 umorov ter da so primeri predoziranja s prepovedanimi drogami pri njih nekaj vsakdanjega.



Sunday was reserved for visiting the Denver Zoo (the professors and their Hungarian colleague, Professor László Christián, PhD, who was on a one-year exchange as part of the Fullbright Scholarship, visited the Garden of the Gods nature park in the meantime) and a tour of the Denver Museum of Nature and Science. We were impressed by the diversity of animals that we were able to see up close. We found the three-day-old giraffe calf to be particularly adorable. What fascinated us most in the museum was the astonishing collection of dinosaur skeletons. We also visited other exhibitions: Angkor: The Lost Empire of Cambodia, Egyptian mummies, Precious Stones and Minerals, Space Odyssey, Wildlife halls and many others. Let us point out that we were accompanied by very pleasant sunny weather throughout our trip, which was so strong that day that it even burned our necks a little!

We said, only half joking, that we had never been to so many museums in our entire lives as we had been in just a few days! In the evening, we met with Alen's relative Fredi, who has lived in Denver for approximately 26 years and works as a professional firefighter and rescuer. We were left speechless when he told us about his work, especially when he mentioned that Denver has over 300 homicides a year and that drug overdoses are a common occurrence.

By the time Monday arrived, our trip was almost halfway over. Professor László Christián, PhD, who is a Hungarian police brigadier and professor at the Ludovika University of Public Service in Budapest, Hungary, and currently teaches at the Metropolitan State University (MSU) of Denver, showed us around the university and its campus and various facilities. First, we listened to a lecture by Professor Meško on community safety in Slovenia, which he had prepared especially for American students, and then we attended a one-hour lecture on information security with the American students.

On Tuesday, the Academy of Criminal Justice Sciences (ACJS) conference officially began with the registration of participants, and on Wednesday, after a breakfast for new members, round tables and presentations in the various sections began, which we attended. In the evening, we attended a reception hosted by this year's ACJS president, Professor Bitna Kim. As part of the educational activities, we attended a very intense Trivia night. We tested our knowledge of Denver and the USA on the topics of history, politics, criminology, and pop culture. We achieved an excellent 5th place out of a total of 14 teams, a result of which we are very proud. Let us emphasize that we were the only non-American team! There were some funny moments, because due to our "ignorance" we managed to make the entire hall laugh with the answer that the titles of Agatha Christie's crime novels represent the titles of children's songs. Well done!

All-girls all-star team




